TERMS OF REFERENCE

CLUB HISTORY COMMITTEE

January 2013

The History Committee is a new committee of the SLNC. It is responsible to the Board of Directors; reporting at the monthly Board meetings. The Committee was established in fall 2012, with the 2012-2013 season being an initial organizational period.

PURPOSE :

- 1. To preserve the historical resources of the ski club.
- 2. Honour the legacy of the ski pioneers, volunteers, families, and others who have contributed to the club and to the sport of XC skiing in the North Okanagan.
- 3. Identify and cooperatively undertake projects targeted at preserving and highlighting club history.

ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Continue on-going activities such as scrap-booking.
- 2. Write short history-themed pieces for inclusion in club newsletters.
- 3. Identify and collate sources of historical information (written) as well as individuals who could contribute stories and photos.
- 4. Interview "old timers" and seek out photos for archiving.
- 5. Spearhead development of a planned interpretive club history display for the new lodge. (the story of our ski club as told with words and images, as well as possible themed displays).
- 6. Seek partnerships to support or implement projects, e.g. with Vernon museum and archives, other ski club initiatives, and club committees.
- 7. As necessary, seek grant or other funding sources to support any major projects that cannot be done by volunteering or in-kind contributions.

COMPOSITION:

Board member Volunteers (1-4+)

1 Volunteer would serve as committee lead or chairperson

REPORTING:

Provide reports to the Board as needed at regular board meetings. Report to the club membership at least once per year (e.g. at the AGM).
