

TERMS OF REFERENCE

SLNC COMPETITIONS COMMITTEE

August 2007

The Competitions Committee is a standing committee of the SLNC. It is responsible to the Board of Directors; reports to the monthly Board meetings, and to the Club Manager.

PURPOSE :

1. Long range and annual planning of Nordic competitions, including recreational, local, provincial, and national scale

SLNC Races are held to:

- a). provide opportunities for our racers to compete locally
 - b)** provide revenue/financial gain.
 - c) raise the profile of our club
2. Train officials to create a larger, stronger cadre of qualified volunteers.
 3. Review and approve race budgets and ensure hosted events are self funded
 4. Assist SLNC in improving venue for Nordic, biathlon, and para-nordic events.
 5. Support the Board Special Events Committee/Task Force in pursuing major international events.

MAJOR TASKS:

1. Set race schedule in the spring for the following year and submit calendar to CCBC prior to the deadline for publication in the CCBC magazine. Coordinate annual events with CCBC, CCC, Loppet Series coordinator, Club Programmer, etc
2. Coordinate the development of Race Officials (Officials Coordinator)
3. Ensure Chief officials are in place for each Nordic event at SLNC
4. Upgrade competitions equipment and help fund the racing program with funding from competitions/events profits, income from Grants, etc.
5. Develop and follow policy regarding loan/rental of SLNC equipment to other clubs, groups.
6. Maintain inventory
