

Dog Owner Code of Conduct Agreement 2018/19

- 1. Owners are fully responsible for their dogs. Where an incident involving a dog takes place, the owner is 100% responsible.
- 2. Aggressive behaviour towards humans or other dogs (e.g. charging, growling, snapping, and jumping on people or other dogs) is unacceptable. Dog passes will be immediately be revoked for this aggressive nature.
- 3. The owner is responsible for ensuring he/she has adequate skiing abilities to stay in control of their dog at all times, on all terrain.
- 4. The owners must clean up after their dog and dispose of the waste in the available receptacles or carry with them until a receptacle is available. Throwing dog poo bags into the trees is akin to littering and fine will be issued to the owner with ski passes potentially revoked.
- 5. Report all unsafe practices to lodge counter staff immediately.
- 6. Respect the space of other individuals and keep your dog away from children at all times.
- 7. Pass other skiers with or without dogs slowly and with plenty of warning.
- 8. There is an expectation that owners who bring their dogs to SLNC will take responsibility for policing the dog trail and speaking to others who are not complying, as well as reporting situations to counter staff or management.
- 9. All dog owners MUST possess a valid SLNC Season Pass. Passes are available at the ticket counter. Please provide a photo of your dog when registering.
- 10. Dogs are not permitted in any SLNC Buildings.
