

Youth Olympic Games 2020 - Congratulations Lucas Sadesky and Ethan Algra!



Ethan Algra and Lucas Sadesky started the new year off with an exciting trip to Switzerland representing Canada at 2020 Lausanne Youth Olympic Games from Jan 6-16th.

Travel often comes with challenges as these two athletes experienced. Lucky for the mom support crew of Lynn & Sue, and a long drive, these two were able to catch the connecting flight to Montreal. Once there they met up with the rest of the YOG team and continued on their way to an amazing experience.

From the Opening Ceremonies to the alpine ski lessons on the streets and various demonstrations at the venues, along with balmy 2 degree sunny weather, the energy and excitement in Lausanne was reminiscent of the 2010 Olympic Games. For the first time in YOG history, all the athletes (over 1,870 of them) from 79 countries stayed under one roof at the Athletes Village called the Vortex. It's an impressive legacy. Out of 99 competitors in the 12.5km Individual event, Ethan placed 36th and Lucas placed 87th. In the 7.5km Sprint race saw Ethan finish 40th and Lucas placed 77th. Ethan competed in the Single Mixed Relay and the Mixed Relay with the Alberta team mates and placed 11th out of 30 teams and 18 out of 25 team respectively.
