



Grooming Operator Job Description

The Grooming Operator is a seasonal part-time position from October 15th – April 10th, 2022.

As Grooming Operator, you will groom the ski trails of Sovereign Lake Nordic Club working under the direction of the Grooming Lead or GM. As a grooming operator a resume listing a minimum of three years of heavy-duty machinery driving with PistenBully or Prinoth snow cat driving experience is mandatory. Grooming operators must also have snowmobile and quad grooming experience. It is preferred to attain groomers that are cross country skiers so they can understand the requirements and intricacies of grooming for our sport more effectively.

Duration: October 15th – April 10th

Compensation: Based on Experience (Base rate of \$22/hr)

**overtime should be expected during high snowfalls and during racing events. This time is billed at the appropriate and legislated rates.*

SAFETY

- As an employee of Sovereign Lake Nordic Club (SLNC) you will follow the operating procedures and protocols of the SLNC Safety Plan and SLNC Staff Manual.

- Attend monthly Safety Committee Meetings
- Work within the Risk Assessment Guidelines as legislated by WorkSafeBC

GROOMING EXPECTATIONS

- Meet the agreed upon grooming standards of SLNC and Silverstar Mountain Resort as directed by the General Manager.
- Responsible for setting Classic and Skate Ski Lanes, single track classic trails on small machines and assisting with pre-season packing of Snowshoe and Backcountry Ski Trails.
- Have the ability to work by yourself and maintain alertness throughout the night as grooming usually takes place between midnight and 9am.
- Work with the Head of Grooming to create a work calendar that is mutually beneficial.
- Work to always increase the efficiency of the grooming plan at SLNC.
- Expectation to learn basic race course preparations.
- Perform basic machine maintenance after each shift and complete prework inspections prior to each shift of anticipated driven equipment.
