WAX FACILITIES:	Teams are welcome to set up tents for waxing in the area under the flag poles between the lower parking lot and the day lodge. Clubs should bring their own tents where possible. There is an adequate supply of power available to connect extension cords. The grooming garage is also available for waxing and secure storage on a first come first serve basis
	(approx. 5 teams can fit in the facility). There is no waxing on the decks of the main day lodge as this is access for the washrooms. The wax cabin is for the use of recreational day skiers <u>only</u> .
WARM UP/WAX TESTING:	Warm up, cool down and glide testing areas are located on Wylies Loop and Montezuma trails.
	RACE COURSES WILL BE CLOSED FIVE (5) MINUTES BEFORE THE START OF COMPETITION.
TRAIL PASSES:	Trail passes for Friday (training day) and for Saturday and Sunday race days are included with race fees. You may purchase additional training day tickets for other days online at the e-store or at the ticket windows outside the day lodge.
