

PRECAUTIONS for S’Cool Ski Program in 2022/2023

UPDATED: September 2022

In order to run an effective and safe S’Cool Program for the 2022-23 season, SLNC staff and the S’Cool Instructors have created a governing document for daily operations related to the program. SLNC will heed all PHO and School District regulations with regard to the suspension of this program should it become necessary.

Staff Safety:

- Mask wearing and Proof of Vaccination is no longer required but masks are suggested for immune-compromised instructors, leaders, and students.
- Hand sanitizer is available inside the S’Cool Ski Cabin and Old Daylodge for all guests.
- Airing, drying and sanitation of boots, skis, poles, and snowshoes will be completed each day.
- Facilities are sanitized after each school group.
- Meet Class at bus and escort to Race Office. Teachers and Parents help size boots inside. Instructors size skis and poles, located outside.
- Snowshoers to use Old Lodge, pickup snowshoes outside Main Lodge.
- Each Instructor enables their group only, from start to finish
- Each instructor will carry a First Aid Kit and Radio in case of accident or injury
- All instructor staff will perform a daily health check-in with the S’Cool Ski Coordinator and will stay home if required.

Management of Facilities:

- Facemasks and Proof of Vaccination are no longer mandated. Social Distancing for all visitors and staff is advised where possible.
- Waivers are signed for parents in lieu of tickets. Each school group must provide an accurate roll call for the instructor and Coordinator for proper invoicing numbers.
- The lodge downstairs bathrooms are available to S’Cool Ski Program participants.
- All Ski Equipment is handed out at the Race Office. Adult Ski Gear available from Main Lodge.
- Parents to assist kids with boots, Instructors will assist with skis and poles outside the cabin.
- There will be staggered break times to reduce building congestion – kids’ lunch in Race Office or Old Lodge
- Adult Helpers and Teachers are permitted to use lodge adult rentals at \$5 each.

Revised Scheduling

- Full day bookings only. (half day only IF schedule allows).
- Stagger start/finish times:
- Expanded Skill-building Stations, close to home, for less experienced skiers.
- Snow-shoeing is encouraged!
